**A SECTION FOR THE HISTORY OF

The I International Congress of the History of Military Sport was staged in Rome in 1997, organized by Angela Teja with the friendly support of the Ministry of Defence and the Contact Office of the Armed Forces – CONI. Now in Madrid, the discussion shall be renewed last but not least because of the general interest in the subject and the military roots of sport in many an epoch. ## **IX MEETING OF THE FRENCH SPORT HISTORIANS**

The meeting is organized by the Science of Sport Department UFR-STAPS, Center of Research and Innovation of Sport of the Claude Bernard University - Lyon 1 and the Institute of Science of Man, Pierre Léon Center. The subject: "Le sport et les français pendant l'Occupation (1940-44)". There will be five sections: the policy of sport of the Vichy government, practised sport of the French during the occupation, local, national and international sport competitions of the period, the impact of sport on daily life, biographical studies.

## **EXPOSITION ON THE AGON IN GREEK ANTIQUITY**
